Friends of Eastbourne Hospital are delighted to be holding their 20th Annual Art Exhibition for local artists to display and sell their original framed pictures.

Ann Caffyn – Art Exhibition Organiser: - We are very grateful to the Headmaster for allowing us the free use of St Andrew's Prep School Gym to stage the event for the 20th consecutive year. It is a very spacious venue in which up to 230 paintings can be displayed. We invite all exhibitors and their guests to join us for a complimentary glass of wine at the preview evening on Friday 24th October.

Dr. Harry Walmsley – Chairman, Friends of Eastbourne Hospital:- All the money raised at this year's Art Exhibition will go towards our general funds and our 2025 Special Project. This year the Friends are raising £250K to add to £750K already left to the Friends in generous legacies. This has allowed us in 2025 to buy £1mill of equipment for the new Sussex Surgical Suite, an exciting brand new build on the DGH site which will house a state of the art Day Surgery unit with 4 operating theatres, and a new endoscopy unit on the upper floor which will make the DGH the biggest provider of this service in East Sussex and will increase capacity for bowel cancer screening, picking up this type of cancer earlier. This Centre will offer Sussex residents the opportunity for quicker access to treatment in a purpose built environment. The equipment being bought is top of the range, supporting laparoscopic surgery in different specialties, a new microscope for ENT with the latest advanced technology, electric theatre trolleys for easy transfer of patients, and a comprehensive patient information system for monitoring patients postoperatively. The second £500K will be spent on new scopes for the endoscopy unit. This is all great news for the residents of Eastbourne.

Preview Evening – Friday 24th October – 6.00 p.m. until 8.00 p.m. – The evening will include a raffle (draw on Sunday) for a painting donated by popular local artist Jackie Hurwood, and a bottle tombola. The winner will be contacted at the end of the Exhibition on Sunday.

The Chatfield Silver Cup will be awarded to the 'Best in Show' painting as judged by an experienced and professional local artist.

Saturday 25th October – Informal painting demonstration by local artist Terry Hobbs at 2.00 p.m.

Sunday 26th October – Caricaturist Ian Parratt will be creating sketches of guests for a donation to the Friends at 2.00 p.m.

The winner of the 'Peoples' Choice' painting (voted for by exhibition visitors over the weekend until 3.00 p.m. Sunday) will be announced after the draw for the donated painting raffle. Slips for voting will be given out with the catalogue.

- 4. Portfolios: 4 for the price of 3 at £2 per entry. All portfolios must be labelled at top right front with Name, Title and Price. Please ensure portfolio entries are suitably backed and wrapped in acetate.
